### Parking Permits – Update

Some faculty do not want to purchase a parking permit and are concerned that the cost of an annual permit is automatically being processed for deduction from their paychecks.

The following is from UT VP of Finance, Matt Schroeder.

*“Auto renewal has been in place since August 2018 and has been well received. If a faculty member would like to opt out of parking for fall 2020, they should email parking services ([parking@utoledo.edu](mailto:parking@utoledo.edu)).*

*As a reminder, a permit is required when parking on campus. The following options are available this Fall if a faculty member decides to opt out...*

- *\$5 day permits and \$50 monthly permits that allow for parking in “C” parking areas. These options can be found through [myparking.utoledo.edu](http://myparking.utoledo.edu) and logging in with ones Utad credentials.*
- *ParkMobile App allows users to pay by the hour in the lot with which they are parked. This also allows one to extend parking through the app if more time is needed.*
- *Metered parking is located by Greek Village, Parks Tower loop, Parking Areas 11, 12, 13 and 18W.”*

Because the first paycheck for 9-month faculty is on August 28, there should be time to stop any scheduled payroll deduction for parking. Faculty should email parking services, [parking@utoledo.edu](mailto:parking@utoledo.edu)
