PRESCRIPTION CO-PAY DISCOUNT CARDS

A \$10 co-pay card is available on-line for Eliquis at www.eliquis.com It is available only to person with commercial insurance such as our UT health insurance. The savings is substantial. The prescription cost of Eliquis has increased from less than \$200 per year to over \$720 per year. Please email the UT-AAUP at staff.utaaup@gmail.com if you have any difficulty getting the Eliquis co-pay card.

Faculty with a co-pay card for other medications are requested to email registration information to the UT-AAUP so that it can be provided to UT-AAUP members. Your name will be kept confidential.

Meanwhile, the UT-AAUP legal counsel Allotta & Farley, has filed three ULPs and two grievances challenging the Administration's unilateral changes in our health benefits including the increases in prescription costs. A hearing on the grievances was held before the Provost and we expect to receive her ruling in about three weeks. If the ruling is negative, we will go to arbitration.
